



Tuition Scholarship Application Instructions

York Community College Ltd. Tuition Scholarship allow eligible students to receive scholarships off up to 50% of their total tuition amount. All students applying for scholarships must submit a full scholarship application 6 weeks prior to their course start date for review. Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need, scholastic achievement or work achievement, volunteer and community service history, holistic vision and service ideals.

Eligible Students Must:

- Submit a complete application for financial aid by the deadline stated above.
- Complete the budget application.
- Be registered for an applicable program.
- Be in good academic and financial standing with York Community College.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from teachers, employers, coworkers, or fellow students indicating the applicant's suitability to the field and their dedication to work and study.
- Submit the tuition scholarship essay.

Tuition Scholarship Essay

Your Essay should be 500 words or more; typed double spaced and should include the following:

- Why you would like to attend York Community College
- What your idea of service to others is and service to self is?
- Community and volunteer experience
- What you believe your strengths and weaknesses area as student and employee
- Any past experience or courses you have taken in the holistic field/or others
- Your vision of your own practice of holistic health
